- ✓ I will use Computing in school to help me to learn.

- ✓ I will be responsible for my behaviour when Computing because I know that these rules are to keep me safe.
- ✓ I will support the school approach to online safety and not upload or use any images, video, sounds or text that could upset any member of the school community.
- ✓ I know that my Computing can be checked and that my parents/carers contacted if a member of school staff is concerned about my E-Safety.
