PARENTS AND CARERS WILL

- read and act upon any information sent home.
- foster a positive attitude towards education and use discretion when discussing issues or grievances in front of children.
- ensure that their child attends school regularly, arrives on time and is properly equipped for all
 activities
- inform the school by 9.00 am if their child is going to be absent
- make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect their child's work or behaviour
- support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour
- support their child in opportunities for home-learning
- attend Annual Reviews, parent-teacher meetings and other discussions about their child's progress
- get to know about their child's life at the school

- attend school regularly and arrive on time
- bring all the equipment needed everyday
