**Intent of PE and Sport Premium:**

The PE and Sport Premium is additional funding for schools intended to ensure additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport on offer. The premium is used to:

- develop or add to the PE and sport activities that Addington Valley Academy already offers
- build capacity and capability within Addington Valley Academy to ensure that improvements made now will benefit pupils joining the school in future years
- We have one qualified PE teacher who teaches all classes within the school.

There are 5 key indicators that schools should expect to see improvement across:

- the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity - the Chief Medical Officer guidelines recommend that all children and young people aged 5 to 18 engage in at least 60 minutes of physical activity a day, of which 30 minutes should be in school.
- the profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole-school improvement
- increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
- broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
- increased participation in competitive sport

**Sustainability**

Our Sports Premium Funding has been deployed in such a way as to have a sustainable impact on the promotion of and engagement with Sport. This is apparent in the purchased equipment to increase the engagement of students in physical activity across the school day. This sustainable as the equipment will be used for years to come and this is embedded in the ethos of the school. CPD will allow increase in capacity and a wider range of activities available for the students. This will allow students in years to come to have the best PE curriculum possible.
